



Bab Al-Zawiya

In Hebron city center, it used to link the old city with the rest of the neighborhoods. Now a military checkpoint stands on it.



Beginning of Al-Shuhada Street

Used to be commercial heart of the city. Now it's completely closed by the Israeli Occupation Forces.



The Old Municipality Square

Used to be one of the busiest spots in the city. It stands between the former Municipality building and the place where the Old City officially starts. It is the beginning of the Hebron people's road that leads to all the cities of Palestine.



Shajarat Al-Durr Press

One out of the four old olive presses in the city. Later it became a wheat mill as well.



Al-Qazzazin Quarter

A neighborhood built in the Ayyubid era. It has four entrances, with a variety of architectural styles.



Badran Coffee Square

Named after the popular café that has existed for more than 150 years.



The Great Mosque of Al-Qazzazin

Was built over a pond in the Ottomans period to quench the thirst of pilgrims during the Hajj time, and other travelers.



The Ibrahimi Mosque (Cave of the Patriarchs)

Consists of several parts built in various periods. It contains several tombs and shrines.
